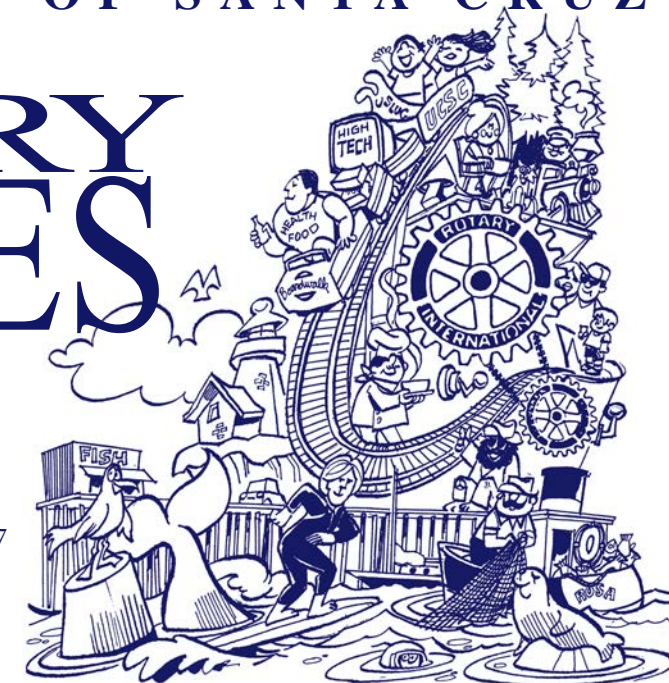

November 30 Program: The Edge

Kim Steinhardt, a former judge, was the guest speaker. However, it wasn't what you may have expected. Kim gave a great presentation on his passion for the California coast and its wildlife. He opened by speaking on Sea Otters and how they are an indicator species for the health of the marine ecosystem.



What I found most interesting was his discussion on the history of whaling stations in the Monterey Bay and the history of the USS Palo Alto. The last whaling station in Monterey was in Moss Landing and closed in 1923. The last whaling station to close in all of California was in Richmond and closed in 1973 with the passing of the Endangered Species Act. The USS Palo Alto was built in Oakland as a tanker for World War I. It was completed in 1919 but was too late for service. It sat in Oakland until 1929 when it was purchased by the Seacliff Amusement Corporation. It failed within two years as an amusement ship.
