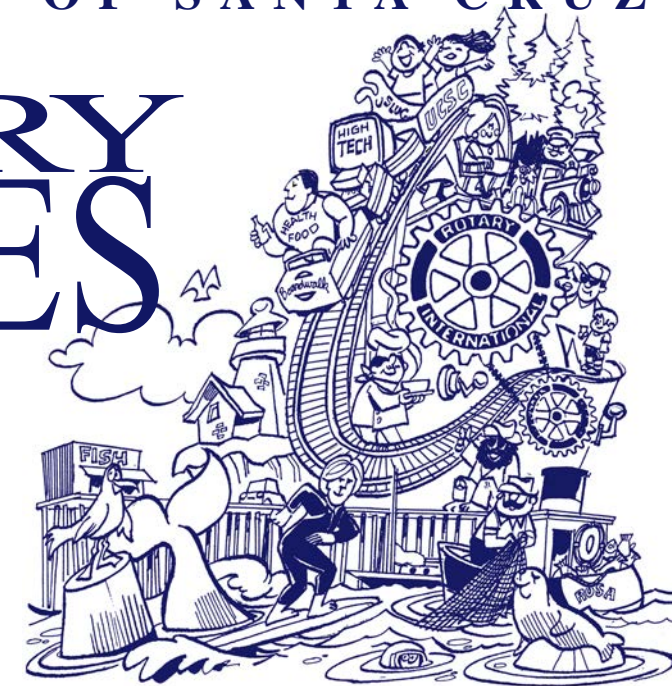

Healthcare in the U.S. and on the Central Coast
