

Detective Report

Mike Allard was our Detective and he took care of all the fines by donating \$250.00 to our Club. Since he did that, he shamelessly took a couple of minutes to “plug his company”. And then he did a really good job calling out people for their embarrassing moments as kids and adults and we had to guess who it was that claimed the moment. Good job Mike!

Program

Our guest speak was Taylor Reinhold who was born and raised in Santa Cruz. Taylor’s mother is also an amazing artist, Annie Morhauser who founded Annie’s Glass. Taylor earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Santa Clara University and then returned home to Santa Cruz where he currently lives.

About 10 years ago Taylor started painting the outside of cars, RVs, walls, shoes, etc.. He then evolved into making T-shirt designs which was his forte. He now designs products and graphic designs for branding products for companies. His print shop, Natural Motion is located on 17th Avenue in Santa Cruz County.

In 2015 he spent five months traveling across Latin America while trading mural painting for food and housing. He did the

same thing while spending time traveling in Africa.

He has been the Curator for many festivals and events where he and other artists paint murals while the musicians are playing their music.

Taylor’s current big project is “Sea Walls Santa Cruz”. The PangeaSee Foundation and Pantagonia store in Santa Cruz have teamed up with Taylor to create artwork clothing to spread the message about Marine life conservation. The clothing was sent to many of the participating artists who hand painted their work on the clothing. Some of the clothing pieces sold for \$4,000. The proceeds from the fundraiser goes toward the Sea Walls Santa Cruz. This project is scheduled to take place in September 2021 and will be the largest public mural project ever. 20 Murals will be painted in one week by artisans from all over California. So stay tuned!

You can see Taylor’s murals throughout our City and County: 17th Avenue and the Frontage Road, Capitola Skate Park, the East End on 38th Ave., Days Market, Plantronics, Aqua Breeze Hotel near the Boardwalk and Bayview School wall on Mission St., and Bay (to name a few). The

Bayview mural is the largest mural in Santa Cruz.

This summer Taylor did the “Black Lives Matter” painting at City Hall along with over 500 volunteers. They plan to repaint this mural every year. At the event he raised \$15,000.00 by selling his t-shirts to continue the project.

Taylor has also teamed up with a sock company “Merge4” which have his designs printed on socks. He has 8 different designs to choose from.
