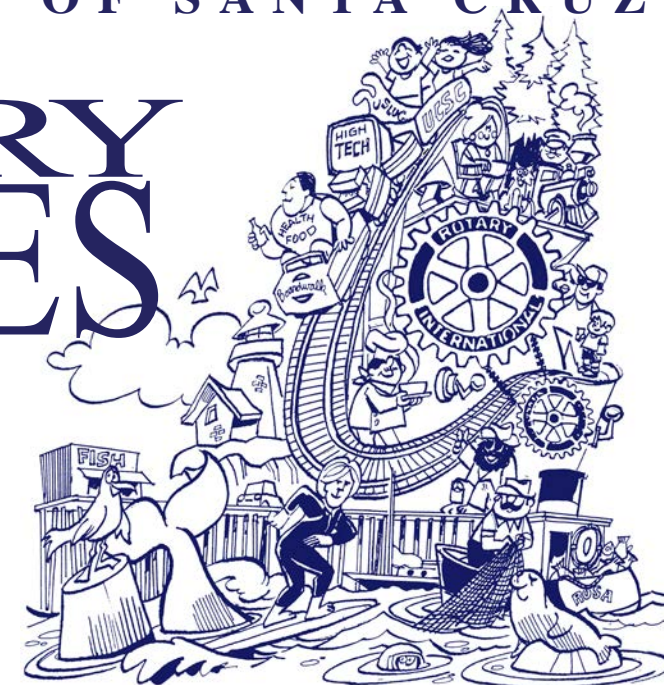

Last Week's Program – Bob Bosso: Santa Cruz Water Issues

Bob Bosso led a very interesting and informative program talking about our county's water issues. There's a lot of laws and regulations in place to *try* to keep this natural, finite resource in good supply, but we're still facing a serious problem: saltwater intrusion in our fresh groundwater supply.

The question on many folks' minds: would a desalination plant help us? The answer: probably in theory, but the plan to create a desalination plant has been defeated and we've moved on. So, what now?

Pure Water Soquel is a joint "Toilet to Tap" project between Soquel Water and Santa Cruz Water to repurpose sewage into potable water. Similar programs have worked with great success in other municipalities. The Pure Water project will allow Santa Cruz to recharge our aquifers for a more sustainable water future.
