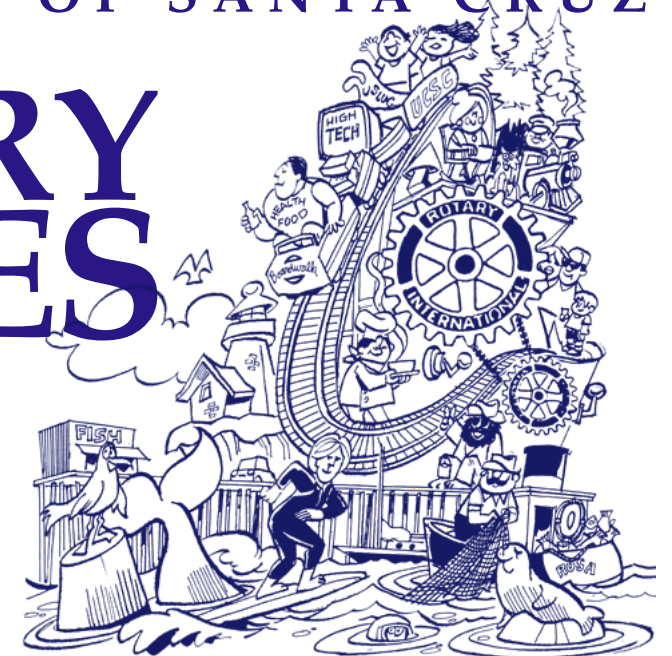

Program:

**Michael Harrison**, as chairman of the  
Vocational Scholarship Committee, (VSC)  
presented today's eleven guests, who  
represented the recipients of the vocational  
scholarships, with grace.

Through the benevolence of the Educational  
Endowment Fund Committee, 43 local  
students were awarded scholarships totaling  
\$30,318. The applicants were competitively  
judged by the VSC on financial need, essay,  
letter of recommendation, community  
service, and completeness of application.

The recipients' ages ranged from age 17 to  
age 56.

Santa Cruz Career Adult Learning Services  
(CALs) program scholarships are \$750  
each, totaling \$15,750 (including the  
carryover funds of \$10,868). Cabrillo  
College scholarships ranged from \$500 to  
\$1000 and totaled \$13,500 (including  
carryover funds of \$450). One student was  
awarded a \$750 scholarship for Specialized  
Aviation. Total actual expenditure this year is  
\$18,682, leaving a balance of \$318.
