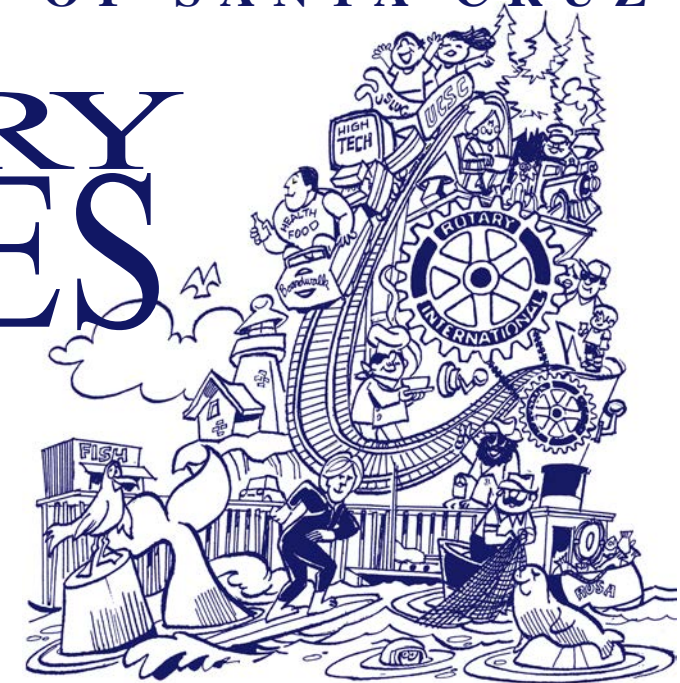

They face grueling exercises mimicking school bus takeovers, major fires, nuclear bombs, search and rescue, hazardous materials, bomb squads, and water rescues. The bay area is a leader in

first response strategies. Our agencies are credited with developing UASI-Urban Area Security Initiative and Urban Shield a program that joins all Public services for a unified response to major catastrophes.
