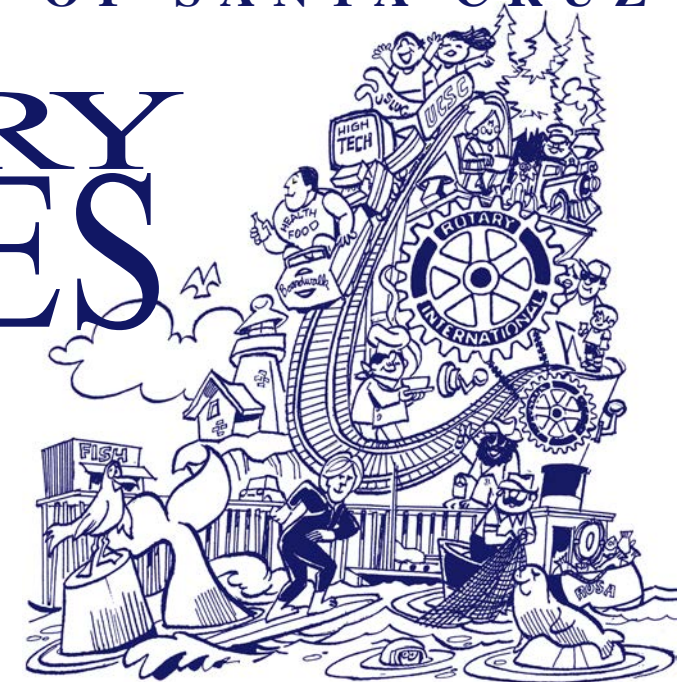

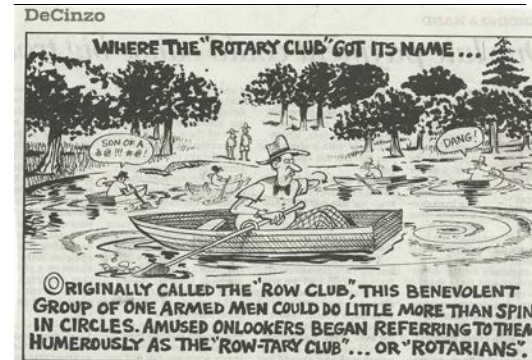
LARRY! LARRY! LARRY! "I feel the love Brothers and Sisters!" "Who needs a program when we have Me!" Mr. Fogelquist took
